OF PHOTOGRAPHIC EXPERIENCE WHO WILL CRITIQUE THE
IMAGES AND OFFER HELPFUL SUGGESTIONS. THE
COMMENTATOR WILL ALSO SELECT IMAGES TO RECEIVE
AWARDS.**

**YOU MAY SEND SEVERAL IMAGES FROM EACH MEMBER. YOU
ARE NOT LIMITED TO ONE IMAGE PER MEMBER. CLUBS MAY
ELECT TO SEND LESS THAN NUMBER OF IMAGES ALLOWED BUT
THE RESULTING PROGRAM WILL BE SHORTER IN LENGTH. THE
COMMENTATOR WILL TRY TO MAKE THE PROGRAM AT LEAST 45
MINUTES. THAT SHOULD GIVE YOUR MEMBERS TIME AFTER THE
PRESENTATION TO DISCUSS THE COMMENTS.**

Commentary, Adjustments and Adjustment Steps.

Commentator may make adjustments to selected images submitted to better demonstrate the results of the suggested enhancements of your members' images and include those adjusted images with the returned commentary. In addition to the final adjusted images, the commentary will include intermediate screen captures of the steps used to create the final image. The choice of which images are used is up to the Commentator.

4. Date image CD will be mailed to Commentator _____
(Director will send you the name and address of the commentator.)

5. Date Club intends to use the commentary. _____

6. **IMPORTANT** – Allow at least eight weeks lead time; two weeks for the Director to arrange for a commentator and notify you who it is and another six weeks after you are notified who the commentator is between the time the images are mailed to the commentator to the time your club intends to use the commentary. This will insure that your commentator will have at least three weeks to work on the commentary and will allow plenty of time for mailing.

7. The day you mail the images – AT THIS TIME – please send a check in the amount of \$8.00 (payable to NECCC) to the NECCC Treasurer to cover mailing expense and the cost of the new CD.
8. All images should be submitted as psds or jpegs and sized for 1024 pixels x 768 pixels or 1400 pixels x 1050 pixels, depending on the format used at your club. Please do not mix sizes. Images in commentaries that include adjusted images will be flattened jpegs in the same size format.
9. Image filenames should start with numbers to put them in the proper order for the Commentator. Suggested filenames are nn-image title-maker name.jpg.
10. Enclose a list for the Commentator indicating the number, title, and maker's name written in full. This will aid him/her in making out the award certificates.
11. Your Commentator will choose a 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winner as well as two or more honorable mentions and will send award ribbons.
12. We will use CD's to record the commentary.
13. Please do not ask for this service where the Commentator would need to prepare his or her comments in December. It's almost impossible to get a Commentator for December. Please give the Director plenty of advance notice when using this service.
